

Policy Plan for Sen Foundation of Research & Education 2020-21

In 2020-2021 the Sen Foundation tried to complete projects launched in previous years. However, due to the Covid-19 circumstances, the realization of these projects has been contingent on the relaxation of the current restriction measures. If situation does not restore to “normality” many of our plans have to be put on hold. For instance, the Module “Human Rights, Security and Development” that we have traditionally run for the Summer School of The Hague University of Applied Sciences will not take place, because the Summer School will not be organized at all. Other teaching activities at The Hague University have been also put on hold. Therefore no income will emerge from these activities.

Other activities that are unlikely to generate income for 2021 are:

- publication a book about a girl's education in Egypt by our Board Member Pr. Joris Voorhoeve
- conducting research about the refugee settlement by under the auspices of our Board Member Pr. Joris Voorhoeve and our new intern
- publishing a book of Basic Needs: including preparation of manuscript, printing rights of the pictures, book launching and 200 copies for Sen contacts

Activities that are likely to generate income for 2021 are (pending Covid-19 restrictions)

- we will submit a proposal to The Municipal Government of the Hague & The Hague University of Applied Sciences on an educational project “The Hague: City of Peace and Justice”. If the proposal is accepted, then we will run weekly courses on questions of International Peace and Security and the role that the international organizations located in The Hague could play in this respect.
- we may launch a research project with The Hague University of Applied Sciences that would contribute to the improvement of the curriculum of the European Studies Department at the very same University
- we consider the organization of an online course around European Security challenges
- we plan to organize a Summer School at The Hague University of Applied Sciences in 2022
- we plan to organize a project aimed funding the education of children in refugee camps in Greece
